## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The committee has found it difficult to recommend projects in compliance with implementation guidance. To comply with the Missouri River Protection and Improvement Act of 2000, Title VII of the Water Resources Development Act of 2000, the Missouri River (North Dakota) Task Force shall advise the Secretary of the Army on a plan and projects to reduce siltation of the Missouri River in the State of North Dakota and to meet the objectives of the Pick-Sloan program. The Task Force will promote conservation practices in the Missouri River watershed, contol and remove sediment from the Missouri River, protect recreation on the Missouri River from sedimentation, and protect Indian and non-Indian

historical and cultural sites along the Missouri River from erosion. They will also develop and make recommendations for the implementation of critical restoration projects that meet the goals of the plan and determine if these projects primarily benefit the Federal Government.

## 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Membership is prescribed by statute, but represents a cross section of representatives from the federal, state and local government as well Indian tribes and private interests. Members are nominated by ND governor and tribal chairmen.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Task Force was terminated April 18, 2022. The Task Force did not meet in FY16-21 because it lacks sufficient membership to meet at this time.

## 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

To comply with P.L. 106-541, the Missouri River Protection and Improvement Act of 2000. There is no existing organization meeting the requirements of the Act.

# 20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

All meetings would be open to the public.

#### 21. Remarks

The Task Force was terminated April 18, 2022. DoD recommends termination. There were no committee activities during FY17, FY18, FY19, FY20, FY21, or FY22. The Task Force was administratively suspended at the request of the DoD Advisory Committee Management Officer on

10/7/2016. The Task Force lacks sufficient membership to operate at this time and, as such, the DoD proposed to administratively suspend the Task Force until the Governor of North Dakota recommends individuals for appointment consideration by the Secretary of Defense.
