The Board of Advisors provides valuable input and expertise in the formation of guidance and policy. Members are required by the Help America Vote Act of 2002 to hold meetings at least once a year. They may hold hearings for the purpose of carrying out the requirements of HAVA.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The Board of Advisors consists of 35 members* who were appointed by a number of groups, associations, members of the U.S. House and Senate and Congressional majority and minority leadership. * 2 of the statutorily enumerated entities merged into a single group, thus the membership was reduced from 37 to 35.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

Estimated Number of Meetings per Year - 1 According to the Help America Vote Act, the Board of Advisors should hold a meeting of its members not less frequently than once every year for purposes of voting on the voluntary voting system guidelines.

The objective of the Board of Advisors (the Board) is to advise the EAC through review of the voluntary voting systems guidelines described in title II Part 3 of the HAVA; through review of the voluntary guidance described under title III of HAVA; and through the review of the best practices recommendations contained in the report submitted under Section 242(b) of title II (HAVA title II section 212).
