Members have also been appointed to provide

professional expertise in the history of African American women and historic preservation.

The Commission did not meet in FY 2023. The Commission plans to meet in FY 2024.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The Commission was established by Congress to advise the Secretary of the Interior in the development of the now-completed General Management Plan for the Mary McLeod Bethune Council House National Historic Site. The Commission is also authorized to meet and consult on matters relating to the management and development of the historic site. Additionally. the Commission is comprised of a number of the country's foremost experts in women's history, along with experts in marketing and educational program development. The NPS has worked hard to get this Commission up and running because it is key to improving the relationship between the NPS and the community that was strained after the site's archives were moved off-site to protect them without proper notice to the community. One of the key roles the NPS has asked the Commission to play is to help develop the park's planning document portfolio. Additionally, the Park is committed to increasing engagement with MAMC stakeholders and to furthering the legacy of Mrs. Bethune through new and updated programming and site improvements. The Commission serves as 1) a bridge between the NPS and the many stakeholders and community members who may be willing to contribute the success of the site and 2) subject matter experts who will advise the park as it develops its

interpretation and community engagement strategy and programming.
