**20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?**

Section 492 of the PHS Act states that the Secretary...shall by regulation require appropriate technical and scientific peer review of -- (A) applications...; and (B) biomedical and behavioral research and development contracts.... This committee is composed entirely of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications in the fields of microbiology and infectious diseases. During this report period the committee reviewed 219 grant applications requesting \$210,312,209 in direct costs.

**20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?**

The members of this committee are authorities knowledgeable in the fields of microbiology and infectious diseases, including sexually transmitted diseases, enteric diseases, recombinant DNA research, hepatitis, influenza and other viral respiratory infections, mechanisms of resistance to antimicrobial agents, streptococcal disease and sequelae, biological regulation of vectors of human disease, immunology and parasitic infections, antiviral substances, hospital-associated infections, chronic and degenerative diseases of man of possible viral etiology, general research programs in bacteriology, mycology, virology, rickettsiology, parasitology, microbial physiology, genetics and activities in basic, applied, preclinical and clinical extramural research associated with the human immunodeficiency virus (AIDS) and related retroviruses. These include, but are not limited to, the fields of virology, biochemistry, epidemiology, antimicrobial agents and chemoprophylaxis, clinical trials, toxicology, pharmacology and vaccine research and development.

The committee held nine meetings during this reporting period.

This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and contract proposals. These evaluations and recommendations cannot be obtained from other sources because the specialized, complex nature of the applications and proposals requires a unique balance and breadth of expertise not available on the NIH staff or from other established sources.

## 20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

The meetings of the committee were closed to the public for the review of grant applications and contract proposals. Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6) of the Government in the Sunshine Act permits the closing of meetings where discussion could reveal confidential trade secrets or commercial property such as patentable material and personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Research grant applications submitted to NIH must go through a two-step review process that includes the initial peer review for scientific and technical merit and a second step of review and

approval by a National Advisory Council for program relevance. In addition, prior to an award or funding being made, NIH staff must conduct an administrative review for a number of other considerations. These include alignment with NIH's funding principles, review of the project budget, assessment of the applicant's management systems, determination of applicant eligibility, and compliance with public policy requirements. After all these steps have been completed, NIH officials make funding decisions on individual grant applications.
