20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Section 492 of the PHS Act states that The Secretary...shall by regulation require appropriate technical and scientific peer review of -- (A) applications...; and (B) biomedical and behavioral research and development contracts. This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and/or contract proposals in the fields of basic clinical and pharmacologic aspects of the cardiovascular, renal and hematologic systems in normal and disease states. During this reporting period the committee reviewed 1,768 applications

requesting \$3,346,133,950.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The members of this committee are authorities knowledgeable in the fields of basic, clinical and pharmacologic aspects of the cardiovascular, renal and hematologic systems in normal and disease states including, but not limited to studies of coronary artery and myocardial disease, cardiac function, hemodynamics, blood pressure regulation, hematology and studies of cardiovascular drugs.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The committee held 24 meetings during this reporting period.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and contract proposals. These evaluations and recommendations cannot be obtained from other sources because the specialized, complex nature of the applications and proposals requires a unique balance and breadth of expertise not available on the NIH staff or from other established sources.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

The meetings of the committee was closed to the public for the review of grant applications.

Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6) of the Government in the Sunshine Act permit the closing of meetings where discussion could reveal confidential trade secrets or commercial property such as patentable material and personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

The following members were reappointed during the fiscal year: Sanda Despa and Bonnie Ky. Dr. Sihem Boudina's term will end two years earlier (6/30/2025). These include alignment with NIH's funding principles, review of the project budget, assessment of the applicant's management systems, determination of applicant eligibility, and compliance with public policy requirements. After all these steps have been completed, NIH officials make funding decisions on individual grant applications.
