20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The Committee reviews journals that have applied to be indexed in MEDLINE and makes recommendations to the National Library of Medicine (NLM) regarding their scientific quality. The Committee evaluates journals based on 5 critical elements as described on the Journal Selection for MEDLINE page:

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The Committee consists of members from authorities knowledgeable in the various disciplines and fields relating to biomedicine and scholarly communication, such as physicians, researchers, educators, editors, health science librarians, and historians.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Committee meets three times a year to review and recommend journals for inclusion in MEDLINE. Three meetings were held during FY 2023, on October 27-28, 2022, February 23-24, 2023, and June 22-23, 2023. The committee plans to hold three meetings in FY2024.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

Hundreds of biomedical journals apply to be indexed in MEDLINE annually. It is important to have an impartial committee which is composed of experts in biomedical and behavioral fields and scientific writing to advise the Library on which journals should be indexed to provide accurate, useful research and clinical information, ensuring adequate geographic and subject representation. There is no other NIH group that can provide this impartial journal review.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

The meetings of the Literature Selection Technical Review Committee were closed to the public for the review and discussion of individual journals for potential inclusion in the NLM publications database. The presence of individuals associated with individual journals could hinder fair and open

discussion and evaluation by Committee members, and the meetings were, therefore, closed under Section 552(c)(9)(B) of the Government in the Sunshine Act.

21. Remarks

Committee Function: Other - Journal Review. The Committee Decision Maker and Designated Federal Official are the same individual based on assigned duties within NLM. Reports: This committee did not produce any reports. Dr. Armand Matheny Antommaria became the new Chair in FY23. In 2022, after an OGC review of IRG and SEP charters, it was determined that this committee would now be considered a Program Advisory Committee (PAC) and no longer exempt from renewal.
