20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Section 492 of the PHS Act states that The Secretary ... shall by regulation require appropriate technical and scientific peer review of -- (A) applications...; and (B) biomedical and behavioral research and development contracts . This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and/or contract proposals in the fields of biology of human development and aging. During this reporting period the committee reviewed 1,232 applications requesting \$2,310,997,005.00.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

This committee is composed of authorities knowledgeable in the disciplines and fields relation to basic and clinical aspects of morphogenesis and pattern formation; gastrulation; cell fate, lineage and differentiation; organogenesis; gametogenessis; pre- and post-implementation development; regeneration; evolutionary aspects of development; and the molecular basis of primordial birth defects; chromosome dynamics; cell cycle control; cell death; responses to stress; cellular signaling; the biology and applications of stem cells; tissue repair; determinants of longevity; age-related changes in physiological functions; geriatric syndromes and diseases; animal models of aging; predictive markers of biological health and aging; and mechanisms of exceptional aging.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The committee held 15 meetings during this reporting period.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and contract proposals. These evaluations and recommendations cannot be obtained from other sources because the specialized, complex nature of the applications and proposals requires a unique balance and breadth of expertise not available on the NIH staff or from other

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

Meetings were closed to the public for the review of grant applications. Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6) of the Government in the Sunshine Act permit the closing of meetings where discussions could reveal confidential trade secrets or commercial property such as patentable material and personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
