The Council was established during the developmental stage of the WIC Program for the purpose of studying the program to see how it might be improved. The program is well established and the Council work has become redundant due to ongoing Federal /State meetings which provide input to the Departments, as well as the establishment of advisory councils by some States, advocacy groups, State agency program evaluations and particularly from the National WIC Association (NWA).
