The Science Advisory Board works under a work plan approved by the BLM Director which includes curriculum issues for universities, review and monitor the implementation of the BLM Science Strategy, development of a statement and suggested policy on peer review, writing various discussion papers, and prepare and present to the Director a report on emerging issues that the

Science Advisory Board thinks require science-based information for decision making.

Representatives include one from private industry, four from academia, one from a public policy group and one from a conservation group. Each has expertise in one of the fields of natural resource management, energy and minerals, biology, forestry and rangeland management, ecology, and social and political science.
