FY-2003, The Advisory Commission's purpose, to complete the General Management Plan, is successfully done. The Mojave National Preserve Advisory Commission was established to provide the Superintendent advice on the development and implementation of the park's General Management Plan (GMP). The Commission has been actively involved in issues related to the GMP, which was approved September 2001. The Commission did not meet in FY02 but various members attended other meetings on behalf of the Commission during that period.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The membership represents a broad range of interests related to Mojave National Preserve such as environment/conservation, grazing, mining, recreation, biology, etc.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The meetings occur 3 to 4 times per year. Sub-groups of the Commission, established on an as needed basis, meet to gather information on specific issues.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

Advice and/or information is being gathered from other sources, however, the unique perspective of the Advisory Commission, the membership of which is intimately familiar with Mojave National Preserve, will be instrumental in the development of the GMP and future management of Mojave National Preserve.

All meetings are open.
