The Council consists of the same 11 members who are appointed to be members of ht parallel National Commission on the Use of Ofsets inDefense Trade established by section 1247 of Public Law 106-113. Membership is made up of members from the private sector, academia, and the executive branch, including Office of Management and Budget, Departments of Commerce, Defense, State, and Labor.
