The Council held meetings throughout the year and attended the monthly meetings of the Upper Delaware (Management) Council and its standing committees.

Members of the Council represented the governors of two states and the legislative bodies of five counties.

The Council met formally 4 to 8 times annually, and was assigned the responsibility to encourage maximum public involvement in the development and implementation of the plans and programs enacted under the [enabling] legislation.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

Opportunity for public input into the implementation of the final River Management Plan was provided at the monthly meetings of the Upper Delaware Citizens Advisory Council. The agenda for each of their committee meetings and their full council meetings included a public comment period. In addition, the full council meetings were routinely covered and reported on by the local media.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

No meetings were closed.

(1) Legislation to reauthorize the Citizens Advisory Council has not been successful in getting out of the 106th Senate. (2) Re #6 (EXPECTED CHARTER RENEWAL DATE) -- The FACA section 14(b) biennial rechartering requirement was waived for the Council by P.L. 102-525, October 26, 1992. (3) Re MEMBERSHIP -- In accordance with P.L. 102-525, members of the Council continued to serve after the expiration of their terms until successors were appointed.
